

Spider Veins/Facial Vessels



- **How does it work?**

Each vessel is targeted individually with a laser beam. The haemoglobin, which is found in the blood within the vessels, attracts the heat and energy from the laser beam. This causes the walls of the vessels to become sticky and adhere together. Over a period of approximately 48 hrs the body breaks these vessels down and removes them.

- **Is it permanent?**

Yes. Providing that post treatment guidelines are followed. This is particularly important during the first 48 hours following treatment. For those vessels that are treated successfully the effect is permanent. However it is possible for others to appear over time. Subsequent vessels can be treated as and when they appear in order to maintain a good cosmetic appearance.

- **Is it painful?**

This treatment is not usually uncomfortable for clients. It is often described as an 'unusual' sensation and sometimes 'prickly'.

- **How long does the treatment take?**

The length of time per treatment depends entirely on the size of area that is being treated and how extensive the damaged vessels are.

- **When will I notice results?**

It is often possible to see a difference immediately following the first treatment. However, some vessels may need more than one treatment in order to achieve the desired result.

- **Are there any risks or side effects during or following treatment?**

The risks associated with laser treatment will be explained to you and discussed in detail during your consultation. These risks are minimal and all laser operators at Kings Cosmetic Clinic are either Nursing or Medically trained with additional training in laser treatment.
